There are several roads leading to Echuca/Moama and several pass through Rochester. This is a great place to stop for a meal or a snack. Why not arrange with friends to meet there.

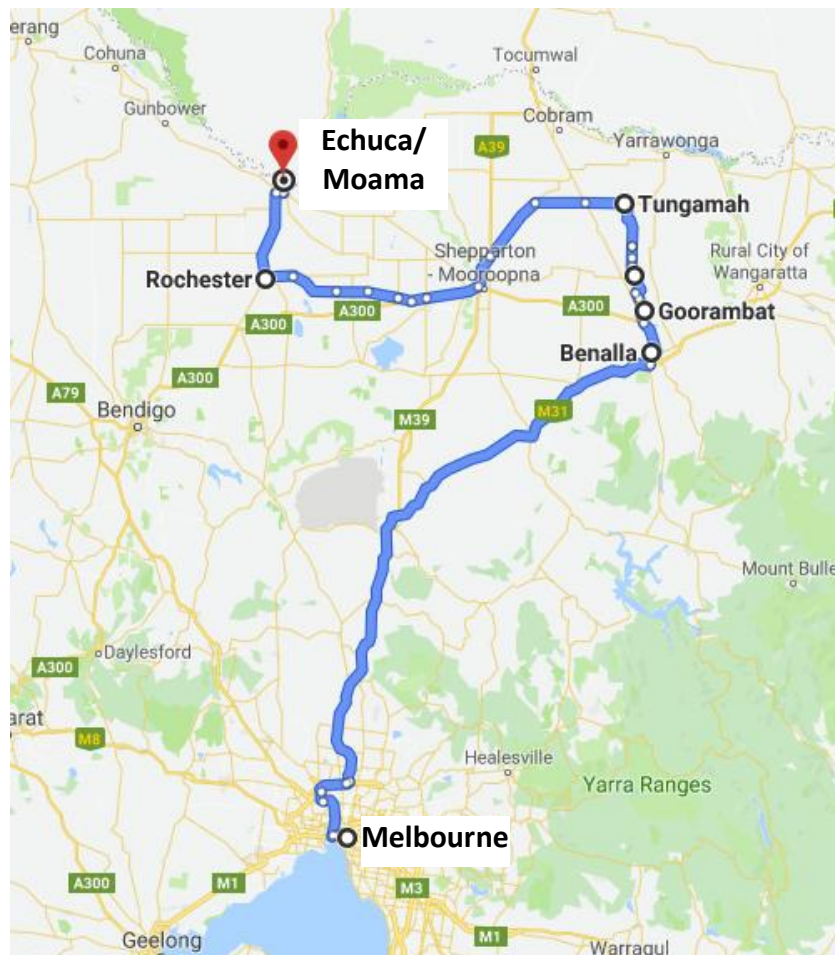


The medium way (4 silos in one day)

The long way (6 silos, Stawell, Mildura and the Murray in 3 days)



The first Victorian Silo was built in 2016 and is now part of the Victorian Silo Trail. Drive to Stawell for your first night and explore the great countryside such as the Grampians.

Next day start the Silo Trail – Rupanyup, Sheep Hills, Brim, Rosebery, Lascelles, Patchewollock. From Patchewollock you can find a local motel or take a short drive to Swan Hill.

Next morning explore Swan Hill and then enjoy a pleasant drive along the Murray to Echuca/Moama.
